
Where from we obtain the requested materials?







What is Inter Library Loan?

It would be highly impossible to add every item published or of interest to our user community. In any case, no library can be self-sufficient or own every resource. Therefore, to meet the needs of our users and fill the gaps in our collection, the Library is offering Inter-Library Loan.

Inter-Library Loan enables you to obtain book(s) and other reading materials which are not available in our library collection, from other libraries. This is done on an Institution-to-Institution basis. The loan period will be stipulated by the lending library. Such materials will have to be handled with utmost care and returned to the library well on time.



Who can use the services?

All faculty, researchers, students, and staff who are associated with IIT Gandhinagar are eligible to avail this service.

What you can request?

Users may request book(s) and other documents which are not available in our collection. The lending library reserves the right to lend and or not to lend.

How to send a request?

How can you get your requested reading materials delivered?

On receipt of such requested reading materials we will inform the respective user by an email for borrowing the same from Library Circulation Desk.

How much time will it take?
