# WELCOME TO THE LIBRARY

Library at IIT Gandhinagar is your window to the world of latest information in sciences, engineering, technology, humanities & social sciences. Being an integral part of academic and research work on the campus, Library provides information services to support the teaching, learning, research and outreach activities of the Institute by creating state-of-the-art facilities and offering innovative services. The library has a fast growing collection of books, journals, magazines both in print and digital format. Most of the in-house services of the library are fully computerized and provides access to many core subscribed online and open access e-resources. A RFID system has been implemented facilitating self-check-out and check-in of library materials.

In addition to the Main Library in the Academic Block 3, a Mini-Library with basic facilities has been in operation in the hostel area from the inception. This library can accommodate 30+ readers at a time and is in open 24/7 on all days of the year.

## **COURSE READING (CR) MATERIALS**

All books recommended by the faculty members for the courses taught by them during a semester are procured on priority basis and organized separately under Course Reading (CR) and Short Loan (SL). Books placed under CR are meant for use within the Library, and SL are issued for 3 days. Library is exploring the possibility of licensing many of these titles in e-electronic format and providing access both on and off campus.

## **ARRANGEMENT OF COLLECTION**

All books in print are classified as per the Dewey Decimal Classification system and arranged by classification numbers (subject wise) on the shelf. The detailed shelf & row guides are provided in the stack area for easy location. Print journals are arranged in alphabetical order and CDs by Accession Numbers.

## LIBRARY MEMBERSHIP

The faculty members, staff & students of the Institute are required to enroll as members of the Library (upon joining the Institute) by filling in the membership form available at the library circulation desk (along with a passport size photograph). This entitles the use of resources & services offered for the purpose of academic and research work. The borrowing privileges for each category of members are given below.

#### VACATION ISSUE

Library offers the facility of borrowing books during summer and winter vacations for longer period. The dates for borrowing and returning are announced one week before the vacation begins.

## **RFID SYSTEM**

Library has introduced an RFID based system where by users can self-check-out and check-in library materials. Besides offering number of other facilities, this system also detects unauthorized taking away of library reading materials.

## **RESOURCE SHARING**

Library is a member of e-SodhSindhu Consortium for Higher Education (INFLIBENT), Gandhinagar, Developing Library Network (DELNET) New Delhi, Ahmedabad Library Network (ADINET), Ahmedabad, and other professional bodies. Library has a co-operative arrangement with most of the IIT and IISER Libraries, many resourceful libraries and library networks in the country. Through this arrangement, Inter Library Loan and Document Delivery Services are offered to faculty members, research scholars and students.

## **IT RESOURCES**

A good number of computers are available for accessing the library resources including online catalogue of holdings and e-resources. Library has Wi-Fi facility for connecting to the Internet and accessing Institutes' resources. A Photocopier machine, scanners & printer for common use are also available.
