While the library at IIT Gandhinagar makes every effort to build the core collection, both in print and digital form in the areas of interest to the institute; it would be highly impossible to add every published item or of interest to our user community. In any case, no library can be self-sufficient/own every resource. Therefore, to meet the increasing and diverse needs of our users and fill the gap in our collection, the library is offering Document Delivery Service.

What is Document Delivery Service?

Document delivery service enables you to obtain a copy of journal articles, conference papers, book chapters, or other documents that are not available in the library collection, from other libraries with whom the library has arrangements for your academic use.

Who can use the services?

All faculty, researchers, students, and staff who are associated with IIT Gandhinagar are eligible to use this service.

What can you request?

Users may request book chapters, journal articles, conference papers, and other reading materials. We insist users to go through our subscribed list of e-resources before requesting for a document. (*see overleaf*)

How to send a request?

Please send an email with full bibliographic details of the items required on any of the following emails:

How will the requested material be delivered?

Normally, the requested material will be sent via email. In special cases, we may request you to collect it from the library information desk.

How much time will it take?

The library will make every effort to deliver the requested material as soon as possible, but in some cases, it may take little more time in obtaining, as we depend on the lending library from where we obtain the requested documents.

Cost

This service is delivered to the IIT Gandhinagar community at no cost. In some cases, the requester may be asked to pay the actual cost of the service.

Where from we obtain the materials?

The library is associated with national and international libraries, library networks, and library consortia. The library is also a member of E-SodhSindu and other library networks such as ADINET (Advance Information Network of Libraries in Gujarat), DELNET (Developing Library Network), INFLIBNET (Information & Library Network), and national documentation centres. Library also has an excellent arrangement with IITs, IISERs, NITs, IIMs, and other resourceful libraries in the country to meet our requirements.
