LIBRARY GUIDELINES

- Only books from the general collection are issued to the family members. Reference books, course books, journals (current issues and back volumes), reports, standards, theses, CDs, etc are not issued to them.
- Member shall be responsible for the library card issued to them. Loss of the card should be reported immediately to the Librarian in writing.
- In case the borrowed book is damaged or lost by the member, they have to either replace the book with a new copy or to pay for the cost of the book at twice the prevailing market price with additional charges as determined by the Librarian.
- The borrowed books have to be returned within the stipulated due date. In case of books returned after due date, the late fee will be charged at the prevailing rates. The Library may recall books issued to the family members. if these are required by our students, faculty and staff.
- The Library reserves the right to decline an application for the membership without assigning any reason.
- Most communications from the Library with members and vice-versa will be over the emails.
