The library at IIT Gandhinagar is your window to the world of the latest information in sciences, engineering, technology, humanities & social sciences. Being an integral part of academic and research work on campus, the Library provides information services to support the teaching, learning, research and outreach activities of the Institute by creating state-of-the-art facilities and offering innovative services. The library has a fast-growing collection of books, journals, and magazines, both in print and digital format and occupies two floors in the newly built Academic Block 13. Most of the in-house services of the library are fully computerized and provide access to many subscribed online and open access e-resources. An RFID system has been implemented facilitating self-check-out and check-in of library materials. A redesigned Library website serves as one-point access to all resources and services.

COURSE READING (CR) MATERIALS


All books recommended by the faculty members for the courses taught by them during a semester are procured on a priority basis and organised separately under Course Reserves (CR) and Short Loan (SL). Books placed under CR are meant for use within the Library, and SL is issued for 3 days. The library is exploring the possibility of licensing many of these titles in electronic format and providing access both on and off campus.

ARRANGEMENT OF COLLECTION

All books in print are classified as per the Dewey Decimal Classification system and arranged by classification numbers (subject-wise) on the shelf. The detailed shelf & row guides are provided in the stack area for easy location. Print journals are arranged alphabetically, and CDs/DVDs are by Accession Numbers.

RFID SYSTEM

The library uses an RFID-based system where users can self-checkout and check in library materials. Besides offering several other facilities, this system also detects unauthorised movement of library reading materials.

RESOURCE SHARING

The library is a member of the e-ShodhSindhu Consortium for Higher Education (INFLIBNET), Gandhinagar, Developing Library Network (DELNET) New Delhi, Advance Information Network of Libraries in Gujarat (ADINET), and other professional bodies. The library cooperates with most of the IIT/IISER and many other resourceful libraries and library networks in the country. Inter-Library Loans (ILL) and Document Delivery Services (DDS) are offered to faculty members, research scholars and students through this arrangement.

IT RESOURCES

Library has many computers to access library resources, including an online catalogue of holdings and e-resources. The library has a Wi-Fi facility for connecting to the Internet and accessing Institutes' resources. A Photocopier machine, scanners & printers for common use are also available. Also five interactive touch screens have been added recently.

MINI LIBRARY

The Mini Library is an extension of the Main Library. Located in the hostel area, this remains open 24 hours a day for 365 days and has a seating capacity for 30+ readers, computer systems for accessing online resources, availability of magazines and newspapers, etc.

DIGITAL REPOSITORY
